

- Calls for the formation of a darknet taskforce tasked with:
  - Continual monitoring of darknet marketplaces
  - Estimating the volume of drugs to be scraped along with average drug prices
- Encourages the reduction of demand for drugs by:
  - Holding awareness classes and running campaigns to educate citizens on the hazards of drug intake
  - Emphasizing the need for educational institutions to discourage drug abuse among students
- Encouraging cryptocurrencies to register themselves with a governmental body at regular intervals
- Encourages a better healthcare system within all nations by:
  - Intensifying needle exchange programs all around the world by WHO to decrease the number of HIV cases
  - Improving mental health counselling for drug abuse victims to cope with mental health problems
- Calls for reintegration and support systems for drug abuse victims through:
  - Welfare program for drug abuse victims to provide general aid
  - Creation of shelters for drug abuse victims
  - Creation of jobs for drug abuse victims for an easier transition into society
  - Offering all working age drug abuse victims 100 days of work or an unemployment subsidy to prevent re-entry into the illicit drug trade
- Encourages the launching of anti-drug operations together in every country using a synchronised action plan including:
  - Sharing data concerning anti-drugs operations between countries
  - Establishment of a dedicated communication system to ensure transparent and secured exchange of data between different countries
  - Establishment of training programs worldwide to train law enforcement to tackle online drug trafficking
- Employing artificial intelligence and machine learning to detect the patterns of criminal behaviours on the dark web and make an autonomous system to alert law enforcement

- Drug transit measures:
  - Increasing pay of border patrol officers
  - Intensifying maritime security
  - Increasing deployment of sniffer dogs to identify suspicious packages
  - Encouraging countries to increase investment in infrastructure to scan suspicious packages.
  
- Improvement of the permissible sector of the a country's economy by:
  - Encouraging MNCs to ethically invest in countries with weaker economies
  - Reducing need for entry into illicit activities
  
- Taking steps to decrease systemic racism to prevent minorities from being forced to become a part of the illicit drug trade.
